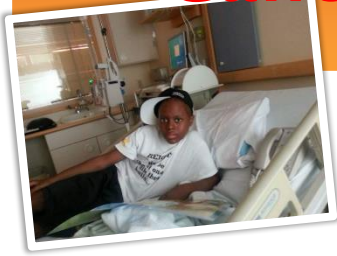


**“Cancer may have started the fight –

Meet Daelon Kelly

Daelon Kelly is a 6th grader at Roxboro Middle School in Cleveland Heights. On February 8, 2015 he was diagnosed with Lymphoma Cancer in stages 1,2 and 3.

Four days later, Daelon received chemo treatments and experienced a stroke and lost vision in his left eye, a rare side effect. It's hard to imagine how frightened this young boy felt, learning he had cancer and four days later losing vision. The doctors assured Daelon his vision will return as swelling in his brain decreases.

In February 2016, Daelon's cancer went into remission. He returned to school but side effects of chemo, including nerve damage in his legs, make it hard for him and he struggles socially and academically.

Daelon had spent 10 months in University Hospitals. He was readmitted to the hospital in July of 2016 due to pneumonia. His mother Yvette had to stop working at the Cleveland Institute of Art to care for her son. The family has experienced challenging emotional and financial hardship ---- but keep pushing on in faith.
